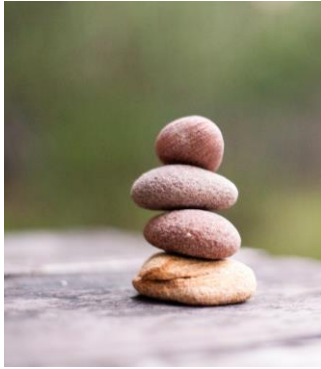

The PTF-RNFRO is hosting an outreach event on its draft report, whose key findings will be shared during the event. The draft report has been developed after conducting fieldwork that involved an assessment of the following:

- reporting practices on sustainability-related risks, opportunities, and linkage to the business model. These practices are identified based on a review of a sample of companies guided by assessment criteria and a practical framework that was developed by the PTF-RNFRO;
- user needs and expectations, the extent to which these are addressed by current reporting practices and challenges faced by companies in providing such information; and
- innovative reporting data and technology use cases.

The PTF-RNFRO aims to discuss and exchange views with stakeholders on its key findings and seek input prior to publishing its final report in the early summer. Your contributions will be highly valued!
