### Cover Note

#### Objective

- 1 Approve the new batch of categorizations sent to SRB in advance of this meeting (paper 06-02).

#### Background

- 1 As of 31 January, EFRAG has received 258 questions, including 99 related to the cross-cutting, 56 to the environment, 49 to the social standards and 7 to the governance standards.
- 2 Approval of categorisations: As of 31 January 2024, SRB has approved four batches of categorisations, amounting to 89 questions. The new batch of categorisations (paper 06-02) has 43 questions.

- 3 Does the SRB approve the suggested question categorisations in document 06-02?

- 4 SRB will discuss/approve new categorisations and requested to review the next batch of explanations approved by SR TEG in a public SRB session on 21 February 2024 (tbc).

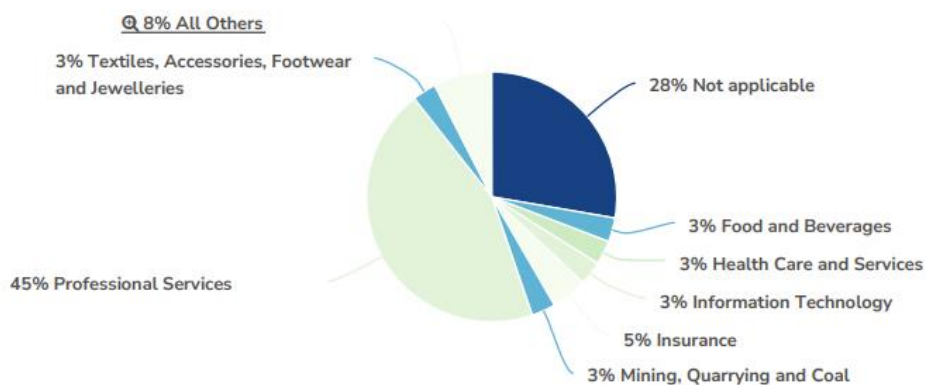

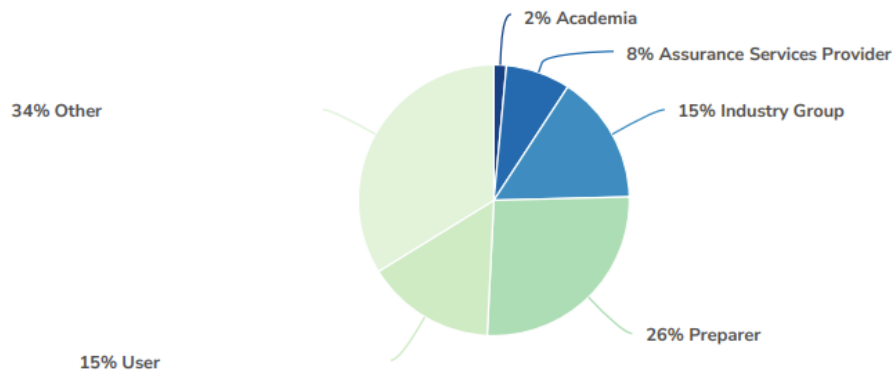
