Q&A Platform approval of categorisations and explanations

Cover Note

Objectives

- 1 Firstly, to review and raise any objections to the latest batch of categorised questions approved by the SRB (paper 06-02).
- 2 Secondly, to review and approve the explanations objected by SR TEG in previous public sessions (paper 06-03).
- 3 Thirdly, to review and approve a new batch of draft explanations provided by EFRAG secretariat for questions categorized as 'explanations' by SRB (paper 06-04).

Background of the EFRAG discussions

- 4 As per the EFRAG due process for the Q&A workstream, the SRB approved a new batch of categorisations in its meeting on 21 February 2024 (see paper 06-02).
- 5 If the SR TEG has objections to any of the categorisations, these will be voiced in the meeting or sent to EFRAG Secretariat as a written objection in advance of the meeting.
- 6 Explanations related to the questions ID 201, 251, 291, 440 were objected by the SR TEG on 1 February. EFRAG Secretariat has addressed the comments received by the SR TEG and the reviewed explanations will be considered for approval (see paper 06-03).
- 7 Explanation related to ID 32 was objected by SRB during the public session on 21 February 2024, it is presented again to SR TEG with two alternative options asking for a decision which of them to follow (see paper 06-03).
- 8 If the SR TEG has objections to any of the draft explanations (paper 06-04), these will be voiced in the meeting or sent to EFRAG Secretariat as a written objection in advance of the meeting, mentioning ID number of the explanation and proposed adjustment to the draft answer.
- 9 As of 22 February, EFRAG has received 304 questions, including 105 related to the crosscutting, 78 to the environment and 55 to the social standards. Please see Appendix 1 of this cover note for further statistics on the questions received so far.

Questions for EFRAG SR TEG

- 10 Does EFRAG SR TEG have objections to any of the categorisations approved by the SRB in agenda paper 06-02?
- 11 Which of the two options proposed should be used for explanation ID 32 (see paper 06-03)?
- 12 Does the SR TEG approve the other reviewed explanations (paper 06-03)?
- 13 Does EFRAG SR TEG approve the draft explanations in agenda paper 06-04 (subject to editorial review)?

Next steps


- 14 The SR TEG will discuss/review the next batch of categorisations per written no objection proposal and/or review in a public session (March 2024, tbc).








Q&A Categorisations and explanations – Cover Note
